

SOCIAL SECURITY FOREIGN STUDENT

Welcome to France! You must carry out certain formalities in order to obtain reimbursements for your healthcare expenses in the event of illness or accident.

The French healthcare system offers a scheme especially for students. **Don't** panic; we'll explain everything to you below.



Social security is the organisation that reimburses you between 15 and 70% of your healthcare expenses. Student social security is handled by student mutual companies.

To benefit from student social security, **you must be registered at an approved further education establishment** and be legally resident in France for the 2017/2018 university year (from 01/09/2017 to 31/08/2018 in accordance with current regulations).

Your situation then depends on **your age and your country of origin** (depending on agreements between your country and France with regard to healthcare).



LMDE, the exclusive partner of Assurance Maladie, **is the social security provider for students**.

Do I have a right to student social security?

You've been resident in France for longer than 3 months and you're less than 28 years old between 01/09/2017 and 31/08/2018: you must enter LMDE as your student social security provider when you register for further education.

You've been resident in France for longer than 3 months and you're over 28 years oldbetween 01/09/2017 and 31/08/2018: you must contact Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie in your home town. You will find all the addresses on ameli.fr.

You've been resident for less than 3 months: you cannot benefit from French social security but you can have full protection with LMDE Foreign Student Coverage. Further information is available from LMDE advisers.



How do I get a social security number?


After you have registered, you must send the following to LMDE Assurance Maladie - 35070 Rennes Cedex 9:

- your bank details, so that you can receive reimbursements,
- your original birth certificate and a copy in French (translation done by a sworn translator or the certificate is in French),
- a copy of a valid identity document (passport or European identity card),
 - → for persons born outside Europe, **a current residence permit**(for your first year in France: a copy of the long-stay visa used as a residence permit (VLS-TS)),
- a copy of the education certificate stating LMDE as the student social security centre.

Personal documents issued by a foreign authority must, unless they originate in a country exempt from this formality, be legalised or annotated.

What is the difference between social security and a mutual?

Social security only reimburses you for between 15 and 70% of your healthcare costs. **To supplement your healthcare reimbursements, it is essential that you belong to a mutual suited to your needs as a student.** This is why LMDE has created several solutions, adapted to your situation.
